Point score nights	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Entry level competition for people new to swimming, where they can record their first official times • Run approximately 1-2 times a term on the last Friday of the month • Open to all Swimming Club Members & Squid Squad swimmers • At the end of the swimming year a “Point Score Champion” is crowned with points awarded from bettering your personal best time 	Not applicable
Open Carnivals	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hosted by individual clubs around the state in both a 25 and 50 metre pool • Each club determines the date/time of their carnival • Open to all competitors • West Coast Swim Club currently joins with Pt Augusta to hold an “Up in the Eyre” two day carnival held in the Pt Augusta 50 metre outside pool. Held around November each year • There are many choices of events at all of these competitions and medals are awarded as per the handbook 	Not applicable (some exceptions may apply)
Country Champs Superfish	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A high standard of competition held over 3-4 days by one of the swimming clubs in Country SA with a 50 metre pool • The host is usually determined on a rotational basis • Open only to swimmers from non-metro clubs • Generally, the club will coordinate accommodation • This is one of the main competitions for a large percentage of our country swimmers and possibly the main competition in our club calendar • At Country Champs if you have younger siblings attending with a qualified family member they can attend the superfish event 	Yes – refer to swimming SA Handbook or visit our website
Junior Excellence (JX) Open to 9 – 16 year olds	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Open to all junior swimmers aged 11 and under • A high standard of competition • A series of 6 comps, usually held at the Marion Aquatic Centre in both SC and LC formats • 9-10 year olds times will be from both short & long course • 11-16 year olds the times will be selected from long course only 	Not applicable
Division 2 (Development Meets)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Open to all swimmers aged 12 and over • A high standard competition for swimmers yet to achieve Div 1 times • A series of 6 comps, usually held at the Marion Aquatic Centre in both SC and LC formats • Break times apply – once you have achieved a break time you must then swim in Div 1 for that particular event 	Not applicable (however break times apply)
Division 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Open to swimmers that have achieved relevant qualifying times • You can only enter races for which you have achieved the qualifying time for • Times are set according to gender and age • The highest standard of regular competition in SA • A series of 6 comps held at the Marion Aquatic Centre in both LC and SC formats 	Yes – refer to Swimming SA handbook or our website
State SC and LC championships	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Open to swimmers that have achieved relevant qualifying times • You can only enter races for which you have achieved qualifying times • Held at the Marion Aquatic Centre once in LC and once in SC format at different times throughout the year • The highest standard of competition in SA 	Yes – refer to Swimming SA handbook or our website
